

TRANSITION MEASURES TOWARDS THE NEW NORMALITY: PHASE 2

In the gradual reduction of the extraordinary measures restricting mobility and social contact established by Royal Decree 463/2020 of 14 March, and for the gradual recovery of daily life and economic activity, in the light of the positive epidemiological trend, the Government implements the following measures in the territorial units in Phase 2 of the confinement.

The **main measures** include:

- Measures to ensure the protection of workers at their workplace.
- In the social field, relaxation of the measures of movement, vigil ceremonies, burial sites and religious sites.
- In the retail and service provision trade, shopping centres are opened up to a maximum capacity of 40 % and ensuring a distance of 2 metres with signs, maintaining the ban on remaining in the common areas and recreational areas. Priority attention to citizens over 65 years old and measures for non-manipulation of products and foods.
- In the hotel and restaurant activities, the premises are opened up to 40 % of its capacity. The service is allowed only on a table basis, with the express prohibition of self-service bars. *Buffets* are allowed with appropriate protective measures. Disinfection of equipment between a customer and another client, prioritisation of single-use materials, menus of common use and removal of self-service products such as cruets or toothpick dispensers.
- Visits to supervised centres and residences for people with disabilities are allowed, provided that there are no confirmed cases of Covid-19 in these facilities. In any case, by appointment, up to a maximum of 1 per person and the use of protection and hygiene measures is mandatory.

- Measures are laid down relating to the self-employed activity of the research, scientific and technical staff.
- Premises for cultural events will be re-opened, with attendance up to 1/3 of the original seating capacity, provided that they don't exceed 50 people in enclosed spaces or 400 in open sites. Group activities only in open air venues, up to a maximum of 20 people, respecting the minimum interpersonal distance.
- Common areas of hotels and tourist accommodation up to 1/3 of their capacity.
- The reopening of exhibition rooms, libraries, monuments and other cultural facilities. Up to a 1/3 of the capacity, with respect for the minimum distance of 2 metres, installing signs and vinyls to that effect. Public items shall be disinfected between users. Children and open access collections in libraries must remain closed.
- Theatres, auditoriums and cinemas are opened up to a 1/3 of their seating capacity with a maximum of 50 people in closed locations and 400 in open sites.
- Conditions are extended for the exercise of professional sports activities, federated, non-professional federated, etc. Professional leagues will also be resumed, while maintaining the measures of hygiene, opening hours, protection and 2 meters of interpersonal distance, and avoiding exceeding the 50 % capacity of the installation. Group activities are allowed up to a maximum of 14 people. The media shall not be able to attend the training sessions, however, this is permitted in the event of competitions that will take place without public.

- Reopening of the recreational and sports pools with prior appointment, for individual and collective practices of up to 2 people, in any case respecting the minimum interpersonal distance of 2 metres. Up to a maximum capacity of 30 % and if divided into streets, only 1 users per street are allowed.
- The use of beaches is allowed in a responsible way. The practice of sporting activities must be individual in compliance with the interpersonal distance of 2 metres.
- The capacity for active tourism activities and nature is extended up to 20 people.
- Conferences, conferences and business meetings are allowed to take place, up to a maximum of 50 people, maintaining a distance of 2 m people.
- Conditions for the reopening of certain shops and services to the public are amended.
- National restrictions are relaxed so as to permit, inter alia, hunting and fishing, while respecting a minimum interpersonal distance of 2 metres. The use of mask is mandatory and utensils or tools cannot be shared.

All other commercial and non-commercial activities established for Phase 0 and Phase 1, with their respective prohibitions or opening requirements, and not mentioned in this Order, are maintained.

In regards to remote work:

Wherever possible, the continuity of teleworking shall be encouraged for those workers who can carry out their work remotely.

Specific hygiene measures:

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If the work is to be carried out in person, such as hygiene and prevention measures for workers and, where appropriate, public or local premises, the provision of water, soap, or hydroalcoholic gels shall be ensured. Should it not be possible to guarantee the minimum underground safety distance of two metres both in jobs and in common areas, workers shall be provided with protective equipment and shall be informed of their proper use. In the case of a supplier/consumer service, the interpersonal space may be reduced to one metre where there are protection or barrier elements. The fingerprint data shall be replaced by any other system.

The holder of the economic activity must ensure that cleaning and disinfection measures are taken appropriate to the characteristics of the establishments, paying particular attention to the areas of common use and the most common contact surfaces, the cleaning of uniforms, etc., in accordance with the guidelines set out in this Order. Regular ventilation and cleaning and disinfection must be carried out on at least a daily basis to enable air to be renewed. In relation to the clients of an establishment, the cleaning and disinfection of equipment between a client shall be ensured, the use of single-use materials shall be prioritised, the use of commonly used letters or menus shall not be used and self-service products shall be removed, inter alia.

Payment by card or other means that do not involve physical contact shall be encouraged. Bins shall be arranged to deposit desirable material, which shall be cleaned at least once a day.

All of the above, notwithstanding the specifications for cleaning and disinfection laid down for specific sectors.

The relaxation of social measures:

Movement by territorial unit is allowed, without prejudice to other exceptions justifying the movement within the national territory.

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People up to 70 years of age may carry out non-professional physical activity under the same conditions as until now, except between 10am and 12pm, and between 7pm and 8pm, which are exclusive for people above the age of 70.

and burrowing: Maximum capacity of 25 roosters in open spaces and 15 in enclosed spaces. In relation to burial or dismissal, the capacity of a maximum of 25 people is limited to a maximum of people in addition to the Minister of Religious Affairs.

Places of worship: Assistance is permitted up to a maximum capacity of 50 %.

Nuptial ceremonies: up to 50 % of their seating or up to 100 people in open air and 50 in enclosed spaces.
