THE CATALAN ACTION PLAN FOR THE NEW NORMALITY

Yesterday, the **DECREE 63/2018, of June 18, of the new governance of the health emergency caused by COVID-19 and the start of the phase of the resumption in the territory of Catalonia**, was approved, which determines for the purposes of 00:00 hours on 06/19/2020, the completion of Phase 3 of the Plan of De-escalation towards a New Normal in the whole territory of Catalonia. Royal Decree 463/2020, of March 14, which declared a state of alarm, centralized the powers in the state organizational structure to the central government and which, as of today, 06/19/2020, have no effect in Catalonia.

For this reason, mobility restrictions are lifted and is adopted the **RESOLUTION SLT /_____ / 2020 ([read here](#)) of June 18, which adopts basic protection and organizational measures to prevent the risk of transmission and favour the containment of infection by SARS-CoV-2**, which approves the PROCICAT Action Plan.

General measures:

- Duty of protection: Individual and collective protection measures must be adopted based on frequent hand hygiene, avoiding coughing directly into the air, avoiding new social groups, respecting the minimum physical interpersonal distance and, when not possible, using a mask, the preference for outdoor spaces, correct ventilation of closed spaces and cleaning and disinfection of surfaces.

Specific measures:

- Protection of the vulnerable population: Preferential attention to this population group must be guaranteed in such a way that the time spent inside premises and establishments is minimized.

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- Interpersonal physical distance: In general, 1.5 meters, with the equivalent of 2.5 m² per person, except that more restrictive values are established by the type of activity. The distance of less than 1 m is allowed in closed spaces between people who maintain a close relationship and contact in a very habitual way or to carry out their professional activity.
- Use of mask: On public roads, when it is not possible to maintain an interpersonal safety distance of 1.5 meters between people who do not maintain a very habitual relationship. In all means of passenger transport, except tourist vehicles between people who maintain a very common relationship.
- Meetings and social and leisure activities: Family gatherings and social activities can be held, including non-professional sports. In activities open to the public and shops, organizational measures must be taken, systems for cleaning hands must be made available, as well as cleaning, disinfecting and ventilating the space. Agglomerations are considered to be when people who do not maintain a habitual relationship cannot maintain the minimum interpersonal distance.
- Capacity in open air spaces: The minimum interpersonal space must be guaranteed, independent access and exit flows must be controlled by a maximum of 2,000 people or up to 3,000 per preassigned seats.
- Capacity in closed spaces: It is necessary to guarantee the minimum interpersonal space, control the independent access and exit flows of a maximum of 1,000 people or up to 2,000 for preassigned seats. If the minimum interpersonal distance cannot be guaranteed, it will be mandatory to wear a mask and keep a record of the attendees or to pre-assign locations with traffic measures.
- Specifically at conferences, fairs and other similar events: The minimum interpersonal space must be guaranteed. If the minimum interpersonal distance cannot be guaranteed, the use of a mask and the independent control of access and exit flows of a maximum of 1,000 people or up to 2,000 per

preassigned seats will be mandatory. In any case, the promoting entity a) has to keep a record of the attendees. b) You must establish controls of access and exit flows, and internal mobility, through organization personnel or telematic systems. c) It has to provide for attendee circulation measures to avoid crowds at crossings or points of greatest influx. d) You must make soap and water or hydro-alcoholic gels or disinfectants with authorized viricidal activity available to attendees for cleaning hands, as well as disposable hand-drying paper. e) You have to develop a specific procedure to guarantee individual protection measures, especially the safety distance, which must be part of your self-protection plan, available to the corresponding authorities.

- Specifically for hotel and restaurant establishments and activities: Interpersonal minimum physical distance must be guaranteed and pre-reservation must be encouraged.

In any case, sector plans must be drawn up in relation to the following areas of activity: a) Health centers, services and establishments. B) Social services. c) Educational centers. d) Universities. e) Transportation. f) Retail or wholesale commercial establishments of all kinds of articles; paying special attention to shopping centers and parks and to markets on the open air or non-sedentary street, and specific sector plans can be established for each of these categories. g) Hotels and tourist accommodation, including campsites, motorhome parks, university residences and the like, being able to establish specific sector plans for each of these categories. h) Hotel and restaurant establishments. y) Tourism. j) Night leisure activities. k) Children's leisure activities (summer schools, sports, neighbourhoods, others). l) Cultural activities, including museums, libraries, monuments, archives, public shows and leisure and recreational activities, and specific sectoral plans may be established for each of these categories and depending on the age of the target audience. m) Fairs and congresses and other temporary activities with a large influx of public. n) Sports facilities. o) Parties, festivals and other popular events. p) Permanent leisure, cultural or sports equipment with a large influx of public.
